

# Certificate to Teach in the Lifelong Learning Sector



## Who would benefit from this qualification?

This Level 3 or 4 qualification provides a firm practical foundation for all those in a teaching role, with learners being introduced to the key principals of teaching and learning. The Certificate is designed as a qualification which will equip a wide range of teachers, trainers, tutors and facilitators to deliver learning and meets all new statutory requirements. Candidates will come from a variety of vocational backgrounds but will all have access to 30 teaching hours throughout the duration of the course.
