Who would benefit from the Logistics NVQ?

The NVQ Level 2 in Logistics is a suite of three awards enabling learners to gain a thorough understanding of all things logistics, one of the largest industries in the UK. The topics covered include everything from procedures for loading, storing, warehousing, resourcing and transporting loads to multi-drop delivery, safety and quality, international road transport and auditing stock levels.

What does the Logistics NVQ Level 2 cover?

The suite of awards includes three separate progression routes, designed to enable learners in different positions within the logistics industry to achieve a qualification directly relevant to their specific role. These routes are:

1. Carry & Deliver Goods
2. Traffic Office
3. Storage & Warehousing

The award includes mandatory and optional units for each route as follows:

Carry & Deliver Goods

Mandatory Units

- Contributing to effective working relationships
- Maintaining the safety and the security of load, self and property
- Contributing to the provision of customer services
- Completing pre-journey and post-journey procedures

- Planning the route and timings for the delivery and collection of loads
- Transporting goods and materials

Optional Units (1 of 2)

- Handling goods and materials
- Handling goods (motorcycle and pedal cycle)

Storage & Warehousing

Mandatory Units

- Contribute to effective working relationships
- Contribute to the maintenance of health, safety and security in the workplace

Optional Units (3 Of 5)

- Receiving loads and despatching goods
- Placing goods in storage
- Assembling orders for despatch
- Maintaining the safety and quality of goods
- Maintaining hygiene standards in handling and storing goods

Traffic Office

Mandatory Units

- Contributing to effective working relationships
- Contributing to the provision of customer services
- Ensuring your own actions reduce risks to health and safety
- Planning, organising and improving your work

- Investigating the suitability of collection or delivery points for loading and unloading
- Routing and scheduling of loads
- Allocating the resources for the transportation of loads
- Quoting for the transportation of loads
