

# Paediatric First Aid



## Who would benefit from this diploma?

This paediatric first aid course meets the requirements of the Early Years foundation stage statutory framework. It focuses on emergency scenarios that are faced by professionals, including teachers, au pairs and playgroup leaders, looking after young children.

It meets Ofsted requirements for registered child-minders and the requirements for nannies under the Approved Carers Scheme and can also be used as evidence for employees working towards an NVQ in Childcare and Education.

## What does the qualification cover?

The course covers how to deal with accidents and emergencies involving young children:

### Units include:

- First Aid kit
- Action planning
- Treatment of an unconscious casualty
- Resuscitation
- Choking
- Asthma and diabetic emergencies
- Head injuries
- Seizures
- Bleeding
- Burns
- Sprains, strains and fractures
- Poisoning, bites and stings
- Foreign objects
- Childhood conditions (eg measles, etc)
